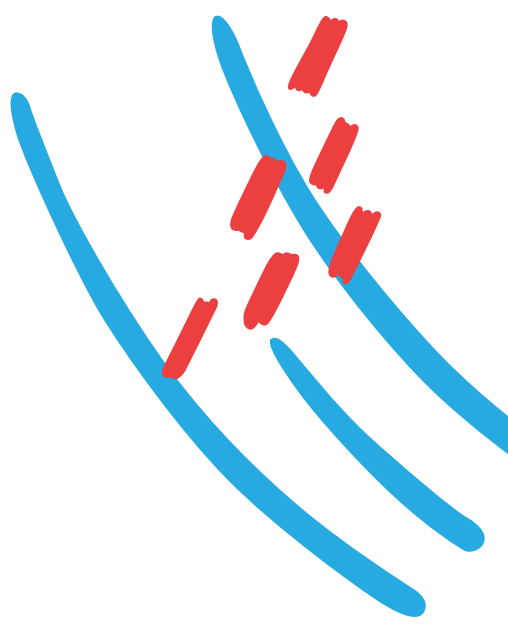

voorbeeld

‘To be able to identify someone’
(‘Om in staat te wees om iemand te identifiseer’)

“I **know** that man.”
“Ek **ken** daardie man.”



‘To gain knowledge about something through studying/experience’
(‘Om deur onderrig/oefening/ervaring baie van iets of iemand te weet’)

“I **know** all the answers.”
“Ek **ken** al die antwoorde.”



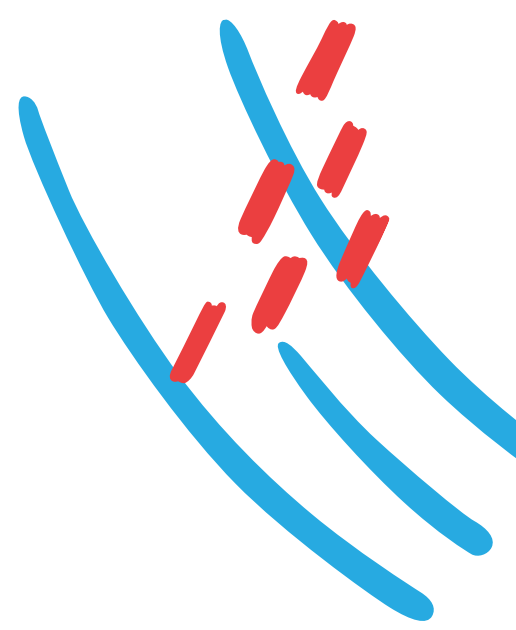
‘To be aware of something, usually a characteristic of yourself or someone else’
(‘Om bewus te wees van iets, ’n karaktereienskap van jou of iemand anders’)

“I’m **aware** of my mistakes.”
“Ek **ken** my foute.”

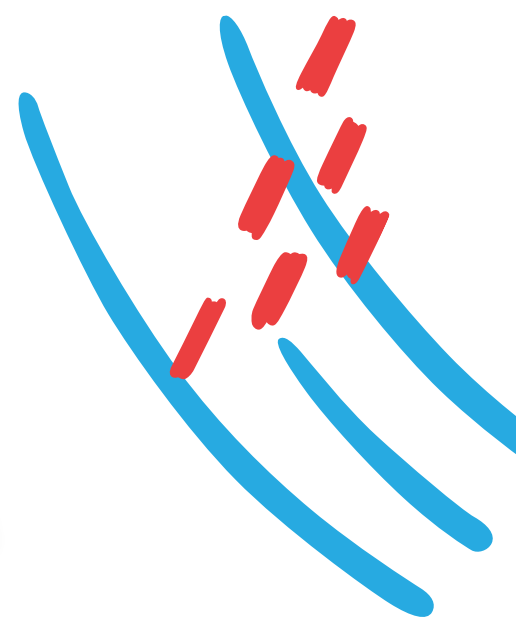

voorbeeld

‘To have experienced something’ (‘Om ervaring van iets te hê’)	“I know a great deal of sorrow.” “Ek ken groot smart.” 
‘To be consulted about something beforehand’ (‘Om ingesluit te word wanneer ’n gesprek oor iets gevoer word’)	“Include me in this matter.” “Ken my in die saak.”

voorbeeld

‘Understand’ (‘Verstaan, insien’)	“I do not understand what you are saying.” “Ek weet nie wat jy sê nie.” 
‘To be up to date about something’ (‘Op hoogte wees van iets’)	“I know Manchester won last night.” “Ek weet dat Manchester gisteraand gewen het.” 
‘Admit’ (‘Erken, toegee’)	“He doesn’t want to admit that his son is scheming.” “Hy wil nie weet dat sy seun agterbaks is nie.”
